Valuation

We provide a written valuation of your instrument including identification of the instrument maker (when possible), photographs of the bagpipe, statement of repairs and condition, resale and replacement valuation.

Scheduling

Please call or e-mail us to discuss your repair or maintenance service. This will allow us to provide an estimate for the work and schedule time in the shop for quick return.

Shipping

Shipping is the responsibility of the customer both ways. We recommend that you ship with US Postal Service. Couriers such as UPS or FedEx are reliable and fast, but may incur brokerage fees from parcels shipped from outside Canada which are the responsibility of the customer. Use a trackable service. Insure the package appropriately. Pack everything with care. **The bagpipes are your responsibility until received at Kinnaird Bagpipes.** Return shipping ranges from \$8 within Canada and \$15 to the USA. Air mail is not available as it cannot be tracked.

Turnaround Time

Most scheduled services are complete within 7 days, often sooner depending on the workload in the shop. As soon as the work has been completed, we will send your instrument back to you.
