Piper's Pal Reed Protector Recharge Instructions

1. Remove contents of 2 jars attached to the reed protector and dispose of in garbage.
2. Disassemble all trays and wash in warm, soapy water. Rinse and dry.
3. Place contents of Package "A" in top jar. Add **1/2 tablespoon of water (7.5 ml)**. Let stand until all water is absorbed (approximately 1 1/2 hours).
4. Screw second jar on top of the first. Separate cotton wool into 2 halves. Place 1/2 on bottom of second tray. Place contents of Package "B" on top of cotton wool. Place remaining 1/2 of cotton wool on top of Package "B".
5. Place plastic insert on top of second jar.
6. Screw jars to the reed protector.

Your Piper's Pal Reed Protector is now ready for use.
