**Classes:** Auditions will be held prior to classes to assist in placing students in the appropriate class. The classes will be as follows:

*Primary (ages 4-6):* For dancers ages 4 to 6 or those new to highland dance. Dances: Pas De Basques, Pas De Basques and Highcuts, Fling, and Sword.

*Beginner (ages 7 and up)*: For dancers ages 7 and up who have not achieved the competitive rankings to move up to novice. Dances: Flings, Sword, Seann Truibhas, Scottish Lilt, Flora, Strathspey and Highland Reel, Strathspey and 1/2 Tulloch, and 1/2 Tulloch.

*Novice (ages 7 and up)*: For dancers who have had competitive success at the Beginner level and have graduated to the Novice level. Dances are the same as Beginner.

*Intermediate*: For dancers who have moved past the Novice level. Dances: Same as Beginner and Novice plus Irish Jig, Sailor's Hornpipe, Barracks Johnny, and Highland Laddie.

*Premier*: For dancers who have spent 1 year at the Intermediate level. Dances: Same as Intermediate plus Championship Dances, Blue Bonnets, Village Maid, Earl or Errol, and Scotch Measure.

Registration is limited. Please apply early.

Classes will be offered only if enrolment is sufficient; some classes may be combined with others.

**Ceilidh:** An evening ceilidh will be held on **Thursday July 7<sup>th</sup>**. Tickets are \$20.00 (adults) \$5.00 (children). Admission for Highland Dance students is free. There will be a silent auction and donations for the auction are greatly appreciated. **Facilities:** The school will be held at Cedar Lodge on Blackstrap Lake. It is approximately 40km South of Saskatoon or 190km north of Regina. It is 7km east of the Town of Dundurn. The facilities are located on 75 acres of land. 
